

## CONSENT TO THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

By filling out forms at <http://innoagency.ru/utm/> the user authorizes the website owner, Moscow Agency of Innovations, to process his/her personal data under the following terms:

1. This Consent is valid to the processing of personal data, both with and without the means of automatization.
2. This Consent is limited to the processing of the following personal data: surname; name; patronymic; phone numbers; email addresses.
3. The purpose of processing the personal data:
  - to organize advertising campaigns and marketing research activities, including SMS and email campaigns;
  - to inform the user on projects and events organized and hosted by the Government of Moscow and the Moscow Agency of Innovations;
  - to enable preliminary registration for events organized by the Government of Moscow and its subordinate organizations, and to publicize these events on the websites and social media pages thereof;
4. The grounds for processing the personal data are Art. 24 of the Constitution of the Russian Federation and Art. 6 of Federal Law No. 152-FZ “On Personal Data”.
5. This Consent extends to the processing, collection, recording, systematization, accumulation, storage, clarification (updates, changes), extraction, use, transfer (provision, access), depersonalization, blocking, deletion, and destruction of the personal data.
6. The transfer of the personal data to third parties is carried out on the basis of the legislation of the Russian Federation, an agreement with the respective personal data subject, or with the consent of the personal data subject. I give my consent to the possible transfer of my personal data to third parties.
7. The processing of the personal data may be terminated at the request of the personal data subject. The storage of the personal data recorded on paper is carried out in accordance with Federal Law No. 125-FZ “On Archives in the Russian Federation” and other regulatory acts.
8. The personal data subject has a right to revoke the consent to personal data processing by providing a respective request to the Agency in writing.
9. Should the personal data subject revoke the consent, the Agency is entitled to continue processing his/her personal data on the grounds specified in clauses 2–11 of part 1 of article 6, part 2 of article 10, and part 2 of article 11 of Federal Law No. 152-FZ “On Personal Data”.
